Current site acquisition progress:

Thanks to some great negotiations we have been assured that we have tenure of the Wesley Mission's Durack site for 18-24 months.

Great in the short term and it gives us 18 months to locate a suitable permanent site, preferably with warehouse, to continue DIK's very important role of supporting thousands of people in the developing countries to our North.

Site options are being considered, including staying at Durack.

DIK's immediate plans

DIK aims to maintain the current container output rate with the ability to increase as supplies may demand...

To do this we are seeking support from -

- Rotarians and Rotary Clubs to source goods suitable for the developing countries.
- Ongoing help from Rotarians to sort, pack and load containers.
- Business organisations operating in the Pacific Region to boost DIK's ability to send goods that have no intrinsic value in Australia, but are invaluable to their recipients in developing countries!

DIK is keen to expand this activity, to improve the quality of life and provide better health and education for thousands of people.

DIK has an impressive record of achievement in this area, having dispatched since 1988 to 30 August 2010, a total



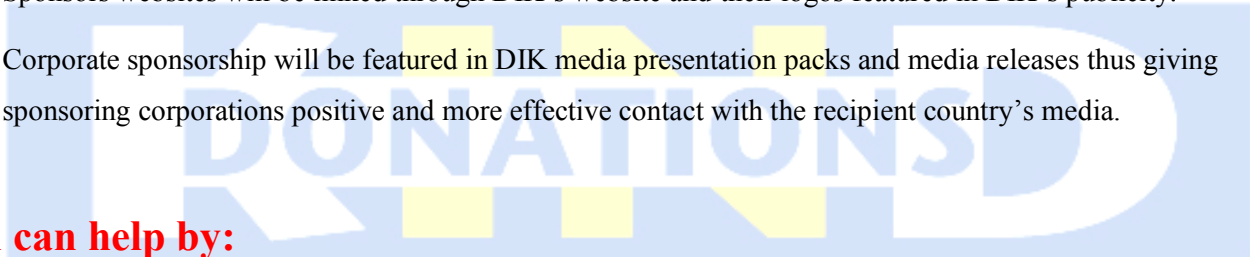
of 625 containers. Containers are currently packed by Rotary DIK volunteers at the site in Freeman Road, Durack.

Goods shipped to developing countries have included

- Medical supplies - Ultra-sound machine, Cath Lab, mattresses, hospital beds, bedside cabinets, trolleys, wheel chairs, birthing kits and small items such as dressings sutures and consumables for hospitals and medical groups.
- Ambulances and working vehicles for the maintenance of community services.
- Educational supplies - School and library books computers, Classroom stationery, School desks and chairs.

The need for donated goods and container shipping costs is ongoing we need support from clubs and sponsors.

- Tax deductions should accrue to corporations supporting DIK. They would also gain an advantage in the market place and be seen as good corporate citizens.
- Sponsors can highlight DIK sponsorship in their publicity to show their support for developing countries.
- Sponsors websites will be linked through DIK’s website and their logos featured in DIK’s publicity.
- Corporate sponsorship will be featured in DIK media presentation packs and media releases thus giving sponsoring corporations positive and more effective contact with the recipient country’s media.
