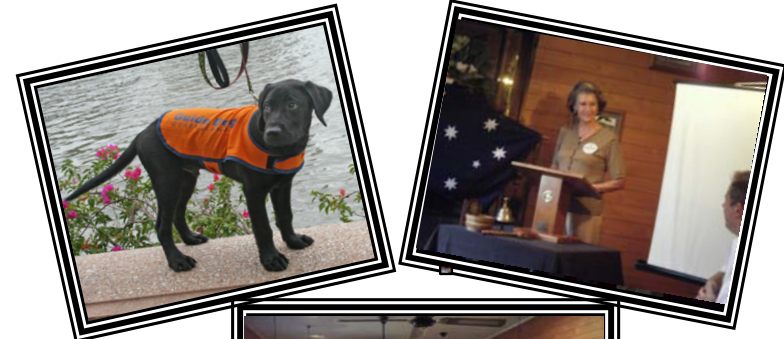

BOARD MEETING REPORT - Wednesday 19 June

-As you will recall in our Christmas Raffle we indicated that the Club would be setting up a small scholarship fund to help needy Primary State school students whose parents are in financial difficulties, with small grants to support educational , social and other school needs. The Board resolved to put the \$2000 we set aside, into the scholarship trust fund for this purpose. It was decided to establish a pilot program at Buderim Mountain Primary School in the second half of this year to provide small support grants of \$30 to \$80 with a total of \$500, to assist needy students. The Principal will be our contact person. At the end of the year the pilot program will be evaluated and may extend to the other three primary schools in our area if it proves to be successful.

- The Board has forwarded a letter clarifying the role that the Club wishes to pursue in the Australia Day Activities in 2011. The Club has indicated that the Parade should be a BWMCA activity and the Club's role restricted to organising the Parade on the Day. All organisational matters should remain with the BWMCA to save duplication and unnecessary overlap.

- The Board agreed to purchase additional larger size vests for Club RYDA personnel who fit into the muscular, fit ,and superior body sizes.

-We have received a request from a student to attend NYSF so Director John Stevenson will be following this up.It closes 30 May.

- Could all Board Members please forward by 30 May your (brief) Director's Reports to the Pres. for inclusion in the Annual Report to be tabled at the Handover Dinner.

- The Club is reintroducing badges for recent new members wives /partners.
