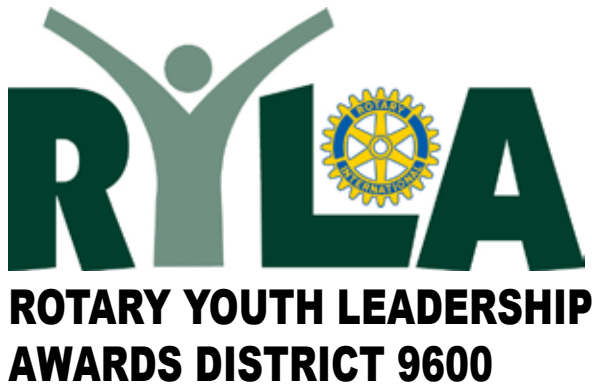

SOUTH PASSAGE

TEAM BUILDING, 26-30 APRIL, 2010

Adventures on the *South Passage* involves sailing on a course over a number of days. The focus is on working together as a team getting outside one's comfort zones. The usual arrangement on a voyage is:

- To have three watches (shifts) of 8 persons
- A watch leader for each watch to instruct and train.
- Each watch takes it in turn to run the ship though sometimes it is all hands on deck

Each watch will learn to raise and lower sails, raise the anchor, taking the helm, marking progress on the chart, entering details in the ship's log, cleaning the boat and so on. We often have island excursions to explore places that otherwise one would not get to see. Beach cricket and football may be run on these outings.

The experience of participants depends very much on the weather. If it is windy, a heeling deck and lots of spray provides heaps of excitement (maybe a bit of seasickness?). If it's calmer weather we aim to get the most out of each day by engaging in other exciting activities. Also, crew can climb out on the bowsprit (wearing a safety harness) and see the boat and the water from a very different angle.

The focus is on working effectively together. We run competitions between the watches such as:

- Timed knotting competitions
- Tacking and gibing competitions (ie turning the ship from one course to another)
- Emergency drills such as donning life jackets and escaping through an emergency hatch.
- A treasure hunt to find key parts of the boat, equipment and rigging.
- Island excursion games

The South Passage tallship is unique and even people who have sailed before find she is very different. This exciting experience will be a life-long memory for those fortunate enough to participate in this RYLA adventure!
